

## Elementary School In-Person Hybrid Plan Approved by the Utica City School District Board of Education: K-6 student cohorts to begin reporting on March 8, 2021

On Tuesday, February 23, 2021, the Utica City School District's Board of Education approved the start of in-person hybrid learning for all K-6 students.

K-6 student cohorts will begin reporting to school on Monday, March 8, 2021 according to the following schedule:

As noted above, all students who are engaged in remote learning on the days they are not scheduled to report in-person (including students who are fully remote) will be able to log into their Google Classroom and join the live lessons with their teacher following the same classroom schedule that is currently in place.

Student cohort assignments have been mailed home to parents along with detailed information about the in-person hybrid plan. Classroom teachers will be reviewing this information with students and parents. Student bussing letters are also included in the mailing for students who qualify for bussing.
