On Friday, May 1, 2020, Governor Andrew Cuomo extended school closures in New York State for the remainder of the school year due to the Novel Coronavirus pandemic.

Teachers will continue to provide remote learning lessons and assignments to all students for the remainder of the school year.

In addition, our Food Service department will continue to provide "Grab and Go" breakfast and lunch Monday-Friday from 9:00 AM-12:00 PM at each school building.

If you established emergency childcare through the Cornell Child Care Council at Cornell Cooperative Extension, this service will continue to be available for the remainder of the school year.

Finally, in his announcement, the Governor stated that he will be making a decision about summer school by the end of the month.
