One of our school improvement commitments this year is developing meaningful relationships!


For our students, our goal has been to have activities and events that are meaningful for students!

The 8th grade class has been meeting to discuss possible fundraising ideas, semi-formal dance, and end of the year trip!






Crochet Club






Chess Club

Technology Club


This year there is over 60 students involved in technology programs after school. There are 2 programs that meet weekly: entrepreneur program and CAD printing program.

Students are learning the basics of CAD (Computer Aided Design) using a program called Autodesk Inventor. CAD/3D printing program is 3D modeling Jack-O-Lantern pumpkins with their own face designs and 3D printing them.

Entrepreneur program is designing and producing CNC wood carving plaques using a program called V-Care and finishing them with a rustic Adirondack look.

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

Trust means people are able to be honest and loyal.

Respect means being tolerant of others and considerate of others' feelings Fairness means being impartial and unbiased and listening to others, Caring means to be understanding of people and helping people when they need it.

Citizenship means to cooperate with, participate in, and give back to your community.

Trust means -able to be honest, even when decisions are difficult

- 2. Being a team player
- 3. Keeping secrets
- 4. Not Gossiping or spreading rumors

Character traits that show trust

- Being authentic Authentic people are not trying to be above anyone else. They are likeable, humble and easy to talk to. Authentic people are genuine, true to themselves, and aren't blindly following the crowd.
- 2. Consistency Everyone has a bad day. But people want to see consistent, positive behavior in the people that they trust. Affirmative actions and smart decisions make a difference in the eyes of others
- 3. Integrity People naturally gravitate towards others that stand up for what is right in life, even when no one is watching.
