MAGNET APPLICATIONS

If you are interested in your children attending a Magnet school other than their home school, or would like your child to return to their home school in September, please complete a Magnet School Choice Application. You may submit the application on-line or pick one up from your child's school office. They are due by May 24, 2018.

SINGLE POINT OF ENTRY

There is no student entry through the front entrance. Parents are to drop off students at their assigned entry doors and NOT enter the building.
